At approximately 1400 on April 4, 2020, Offshore Systems Inc., (OSI) a marine fuel terminal and vessel support company, was notified that an employee passed away in his private berthing accommodation in Dutch Harbor, Alaska.

OSI is focusing on supporting the employee's family and co-workers at this difficult time. In addition, OSI is working with local health care and state agencies to address any issues that may be related to understanding the circumstances and causes of the employee's death. Jeff Savage, the General Manager of OSI stated "Our employees have always been a critical part of the success of our organization. Our hearts go out to our employee's family and his friends at the company and in Dutch Harbor. We will do all we can to work with appropriate health agencies to understand the circumstances of this tragic situation and remain ready to assist our employees and clients to provide the services they expect."

Since late February, OSI has been actively engaged in implementing safety protocols related to the COVID 19 health concerns throughout its Dutch Harbor operations and has no information that the employee's death is related to COVID 19.

OSI continues to implement COVID 19 safety protocols to protect its employees and clients in order to continue providing services. In light of privacy concerns and to support health agencies working with OSI to understand the circumstances related to this situation, OSI will provide additional information as it becomes available.
